HISN Ofsted Report

It gives us great pleasure to share the report from the HISN recent Ofsted inspection. I hope you will take a few minutes to read it.

You will see that the Ofsted team recognised the considerable and consistent strengths at HISN as well as the exceptional nature of the school and graded all areas as outstanding with the overall effectiveness judged as outstanding too.

The inspection was a full section 5 graded inspection of a historically outstanding school (2010). To give some context, the Education Inspection Framework against which all schools are judged has changed considerably since 2010 with the focus now being on the quality of education the children receive. It has also significantly raised the expectation and gaining outstanding was only done by 7% of schools in the last year.

On reading this report, we are exceptionally proud of all the staff and children. The report highlights and absolutely recognises the strengths and priorities of HISN and reflects all the hard work which has gone into making the school the fantastic place it is. The exceptionally close links with HJS, safeguarding, excellent behaviour and our carefully considered and sequenced curriculum were a particular focus during the 2 day inspection and recognised within the report.

During the inspection, parents were invited to complete the Ofsted Parent View. In total 249 of you responded which we, and the Ofsted team, were impressed by. We were particularly gratified as 100% of parents recommended this school and 100% of responses said their child was happy in school. An absolute endorsement of HISN and its school community.

Outstanding is a wonderful achievement but we will not now sit back and relax! We have high aspirations for the pupils and we will continue to strive to provide the very best education and opportunities for the pupils of HISN and ensure they are ready for HJS and beyond.
