## NEXT WEEK:

We will sow some cress seeds next week and when they are ready the children will make some lovely cress sandwiches to eat.

The life cycle of the chicken will be a theme. We will be reading chicken stories as well as learning about the life cycle of chickens. We will cook some eggs and compare what a raw egg looks like to a cooked egg. Of course we will eat some too!

Our letter sound is going to be 'd'. It is good to see that the children are remembering the hand gesture that goes with the sound; this will be invaluable once they start using letters and sounds later on and in Reception.

In maths activities the children will be encouraged to select the correct numerals to represent a number of objects.

Our beans have started sprouting roots so the children will be encouraged to check them regularly to monitor progress.

In our hall time we will play *duck, duck, goose* and other games and activities.

## SOME IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND REMINDERS:

Children love 'show and tell'. It helps to develop the confidence to speak before a familiar audience. It is so popular that we sometimes struggle to find the time to fit all of them in. From now on we are going to restrict topics to **trips, celebrations and things the children have made.**
