



Key Stage 2 Results and Progress 2019

We are delighted with our end of Key Stage 2 SATs results this year. The table below shows the school's results in terms of percentage/average scores achieved:

- 1. The percentage of Year 6 children achieving expectation compared to the national result.
- 2. The average scaled score which children achieved, where 100 is the national expectation.
- 3. The progress measures are a type of value added measure, which means that pupils' results are compared to the actual achievements of other pupils nationally with similar prior attainment.

Successes this year include:

- The attainment percentage for all the core subjects are above the national average.
- Reading, both at national expectation and the higher score, are significantly above the national average.
- The progress from KS1 shows a positive figure in all three of the core areas.
- The percentage of children reaching the expected standard for Maths and GPS is significantly high which demonstrates the priority from the previous year's school development plan.
