



Key Stage 2 Results and Progress 2018

We are delighted with our end of Key Stage 2 SATs results this year. The table below shows the school's results in terms of percentage/average scores achieved:

- 1. The percentage of Year 6 children achieving expectation compared to the national result.
- 2. The average scaled score, which children achieved, where 100 is the national expectation.
- 3. The progress measures are a type of value added measure, which means that pupils' results are compared to the actual achievements of other pupils nationally with similar prior attainment.

Successes this year include:

- ✓ Reading comprehension is 15% higher than the national average, which reflects the impact of changes made to guided reading at school.
- ✓ The percentage of pupils achieving the higher score for GPS is 40% above national average.
- ✓ We have continued to achieve strong writing results with the schools average being 13% greater than national at the expected standard.
- ✓ Maths at the expected standard is 17% greater than national.
