Junior Leader title:	Fruit Stall
About the role:	Children from year 5 and 6 can volunteer to help run the fruit stall at breaktime. The fruit stall runs every day; children will be given one day a week.
Roles and Responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collect the fruit and money box from the medical room at the start of break and take it into the playground. • Collect the correct money for the fruit chosen and ensure correct change is given. • Ensure children do not take more than two pieces of fruit. • Ensure children are lining up in an orderly queue. • Return the fruit and money box to medical at the end of break.
Staff responsible for this team:	Welfare Lead
Candidate requirements:	<p>Reliability - you need to remember your allocated day.</p> <p>Leadership skills - you will need to be able to take charge of the fruit and the line to ensure it runs smoothly.</p> <p>Good money and Maths skills - you will need to be able to add up the total amount spent and make correct change.</p>
Application month:	First day of every new term.
