Junior Leader Job Description

Junior Leaders play an important role within the school. Each role has its own focus and enables our school to be 'the best that we can be'. Junior Leader title:	<i>Maths Mentor</i>
About the role:	<i>4 children per class will become a maths mentor to a peer in Year 5. You will work with them once a week for 15 minutes in an area of maths that they need more support e.g. fractions, long multiplication, etc. There will be up to 6 sessions per half term.</i>
Roles and Responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>To plan lessons in advance and make your own materials.</i> ● <i>To deliver each of these lessons during a lunchtime.</i> ● <i>To write a written review of how lessons went and what the next steps are.</i> ● <i>To meet with Miss Cooper twice a term to review the impact of your teaching.</i>
Staff responsible for this team:	<i>Year 5 teachers – to oversee the maths mentor sessions which will run in their classrooms Maths Lead – to meet with the mentors to review the impact of their teaching</i>
Candidate requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>Partnership – working with a child in Year 5 and supporting them.</i> ● <i>Resilience – when a child is finding a concept challenging to persevere with it so their confidence grows.</i> ● <i>Communication – to be calm, clear and patient when delivering a session</i>
Application month:	<i>February - March</i>
Application process:	<i>To deliver a presentation in March to your class and teacher. This presentation must be in the form of either a PowerPoint or speech.</i>
