Dear Parents/Carers,

Firstly, we would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support this year. As SATs week is fast approaching, this letter will be outlining key timings and events for the week commencing the 11th May.

The children have worked incredibly hard and we could not be more proud of them. We know every single pupil will do their very best during the assessment week and we simply could not ask for more than this.

It will be important that the children get a good night's sleep and have breakfast before each assessment. We would also recommend that the children bring in a snack each day for break time so they can keep their energy levels high.

Gate opening times

We understand that children will be feeling anxious during SATs week and may be keen to arrive at school slightly earlier so the Year 6 gate will open from 8:15am. We would appreciate it if your child could be **in school by 8:30am** as we would like to get the pupils registered and into the Rose Hall to settle them before revision starts. Please ensure your child arrives in good time so they do not miss the revision session and the start of the assessment.

If for any reason your child is running late for school, or they are unwell, please contact the office immediately as you will need to speak to a member of the Executive Leadership Team (Ms Lockey or Mr James).

The children are welcome to bring in a piece of fruit or a healthy breakfast snack, such as a cereal bar, to have before the assessments in the Rose Hall with their peers. Please could we also ask that your child brings in a full water bottle. Please note, nut products or fizzy/energy drinks (this includes Lucozade) are not allowed in school at any time.

SATs timetable

The children will sit a total of six assessments during the week of Monday 12th May. Please see the table below showing which assessment your child will be taking each day:

How the day will look for the children.

The children will be registered at 8:30am. They will then complete the Junior Jog and revision before each assessment. Once this has been completed, the children will either sit their exams within their classroom or if they have access to additional time or a scribe they will sit their exams in a designated room with a familiar and trusted adult. After the assessments, the pupils will resume their normal weekly timetable.

Results

Their SATs results will be emailed via Arbor with their end of year reports in July.

Friday 15th May

On Friday we will be revealing the production to the children. During the morning, after their final assessment, we will share information about the audition process and start to practise a couple of the songs. In the afternoon, the children will watch the film of their production. They are allowed to bring in some snacks (no nut products) and a drink (no fizzy or energy drinks) for the afternoon.
