Dear Parents and Carers,

We are thrilled to announce the launch of a brand-new event in our school calendar: the **Rhythms Around the World Interhouse Dance Competition**.

This competition is a celebration of global culture, creativity, and teamwork. Students are invited to choreograph their own dance routines to a song that reflects the diversity of music from across the globe.

The Challenge

Children should create a routine no longer than **3 minutes** in length.

- **The Theme:** "Rhythms Around the World."
- **Song Choice:** Music can be traditional, modern pop, or instrumental, provided it represents a specific culture.
- **Group Size:** Students can perform as solos, duos, trios, or in groups of up to 6 children made up of children from the **same year group** and **same house**.

Competition Stages

The competition will progress through three exciting rounds:

Round	Description
Round 1	Year Group Performance: Children perform for their House within their own year group. One group is chosen to represent that House for the year.
Round 2	House Representatives: Winners from Years 3–6 compete against each other. One overall winner per House is selected.
The Final	Whole School Assembly: The four House finalists perform for the entire school to crown an overall champion!

We encourage all children—regardless of experience—to get involved, explore new cultures through music, and show their House spirit!
