Candidate requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Reliability - remember your allocated day. ● Leadership skills - to be able to take charge of activities and ensure they run smoothly. ● Organisation - ensuring the activities are set up properly and equipment is put away at the end. ● Good sportsmanship - showing the Year 3 and 4 children how to play fairly and kindly with one another.
