### **Year 6 Bude 2026 - How to Prepare for your Journey**

I am sure the children are getting incredibly excited about their upcoming trip to Adventure Bude next Monday, 14th September!

To help prepare for their journey and ensure everything runs smoothly, please take a few moments to read through the important information below.

#### **Medication**

**Wednesday 9th September:** Please drop all standard medication including return travel sickness medication to the school office. Ensure everything is clearly labelled with your child's name and class.

**Departure Morning:** Any additional medication can be handed directly to Mrs Fraser at the "medical drop-off" area before we leave.

**Coach Travel (Carry-on):** If your child requires an inhaler, EpiPen, or any other critical medication that must stay with them, they must carry it in their hand luggage on the coach. Please note **this must be a separate supply** in addition to any medication already handed into the office.

#### **KIT List**

It's so important that children have the appropriate clothing for each activity so they can get the most out of the experience and are comfortable. Please revisit the [Parent Information Pack](#) which contains the Kit List. Please ensure all clothing is labelled with your child's name.

#### **Departure Details**

We will be travelling by coach, so your child will need a small bag containing the following:

- Packed lunch (no sweets)
- Water bottle (no fizzy drinks)
- Rain jacket
- Paper based activity





- (no mobile phones or smart watches)

Please arrive at school at the normal time of 8.40am and go directly to the Rose Hall

- Please place luggage outside the Rose Hall by the correct sign. Parents will then be asked to leave the school grounds and we will lock the gates at 8.50am.
- Parents can go to Station Road to wave the children off on the coaches. We likely ask parents to **stand on the train station side** of the road so the children have a clear path to get on the coach with their bags for a speedy departure. Please do not park on Station Road as the coaches need space to park.
- Any medication, including return travel sickness medication, All medication needs to be labelled with your child's name and class.
- Children will be organised into coach groups and have the opportunity to visit the toilet before departure.
- At 9.15am the children will board the coach and depart for Bude. Parents will receive an email tomorrow with the coach your child has been allocated to.
- When we arrive at Adventure Bude parents will be sent an email to confirm safe arrival.

## **Pocket Money**

The children are allowed to have £10.00 pocket money. Please provide your child with 10 x £1.00 coins in a named wallet or purse.

## **Friday 18th September**

- After lunch children board coach and return to HJS
- Stop for a packed tea on the journey back
- Arrival back at HJS between 7.30pm-8.30pm
- Please do not park on Station Road as the coaches will need to park there
- We will keep parents updated if the expected arrival time changes at all
- Parents should arrive and enter the school via the main gates on Percy Road and wait outside the Rose Hall
- Parents should line up by the sign that corresponds to their child's class
- All children will be dismissed from the Rose Hall in classes once they arrive back





## Photos

Whilst we appreciate how much parents value frequent updates and photos, our primary focus must always be on caring for and engaging with the children. Because of this, we are sometimes unable to meet everyone's expectations regarding the quantity of individual photos sent during the day.

To help manage expectations, here is exactly what you can look forward to from the school during the visit:

- **Daily Updates:** One message per day providing a brief update on how the children are getting on.
- **Daily Group Photo:** One whole-group photograph shared each day.
- **The "Buzz" Special Feature:** A dedicated "Buzz" feature containing photos, which will be shared upon our return.
- **The Year 6 Yearbook:** The yearbook that children receive at the end of the year will feature an extensive collection of photographs from the trip.
