Coach Journey - Monday 9th Sept



- Small bag or rucksack-Waterproof coat, packed lunch, water bottle,
- Something to do: cards, word searches etc.

- Children can choose who they sit with on their coach
- We stop several times
- Travel sickness- medical form
- Arrive at school for usual time.

HJS staff
