

Frontier Centre FAQ

1. Can children bring Wellington boots instead of trainers for the wet activity?
We would advise that the children bring a pair of trainers that you do not mind getting wet instead of wellies, as wellies are too big for the canoe activity.
2. Can children bring a swimsuit to shower in?
Every bedroom has an en suite with a single shower so children will not need to bring a swimsuit.
3. Can children wear jeans during the day when completing activities?
Children can only wear jeans in the evening. During the day when completing activities, we would advise they are in tracksuit bottoms or leggings.
4. Can the children take a digital camera?
Children cannot bring digital cameras. We recommend they bring two disposable cameras.
5. Can my child wear their Fitbit/digital watch?
Children are not allowed to wear any watches or jewellery. We ask they do not bring them on the residential.
6. Can my child put tape over their earrings instead of taking them out?
No, all jewellery must be removed otherwise they will not be allowed to participate in some activities due to the health and safety rules. Staff are unable to help with the removing of jewellery so if your child is unable to do this independently we ask that they do not wear or bring any jewellery on the residential.
7. Will you be taking any Lateral Flow Tests on the residential?
We will not be taking any test with us on the residential. If your child starts to display any symptoms, we will contact you.
8. Can children take a wheelie case?
Yes, they can use a wheelie case for the residential.
9. Do children come into school on Monday 15th November in school uniform?
No, they need to come into school in non-school uniform, wearing clothes appropriate for physical activity. We ask they do not wear jeans, as the activities will be starting promptly in the afternoon so they will not have time to change.
