NEU industrial action on Thursday 2nd March 2023

The date of the second NEU industrial action is approaching and I am able to update you on the implications for Hampton Infant School and Nursery.

The current information I have from NEU teaching staff is that the vast majority will be in school on Thursday 2nd March and the school will open as normal to all pupils. The usual drop off and pick up arrangements will apply.

All school clubs will go ahead as normal.

NEU teachers are not compelled to inform school leaders of their plans to strike. It is therefore impossible to know until the morning of each strike day whether the class will have a teacher. The teachers who are planning on coming in may change their plans and I would advise parents of all children to ensure they have a plan for alternative child care if required. If the current situation changes we will notify parents via parenthub. If a teacher decides to take industrial action then that class would be closed to all children.

As you know, the proposed industrial action takes place over 4 days with the next date being Wednesday 15th March and Thursday 16th March. I will let you know nearer the time if teachers intend to take industrial action on these dates and the arrangements for the day.
