



What is HISNA?

Hampton Infants School and Nursery Association (HISNA) (known legally as Hampton Infant School Association) is a charity which raises funds for the school. Our fundraising is led by parents and volunteers who generously donate time, money and materials to our fundraising efforts.

In 2023/4 we funded over £20K for the reception playground, in addition to funding author visits, garden resources for school and much more.

Ways to Volunteer

Join our HISNA Committee – We meet monthly to arrange amazing events and experiences for the children. Commit as much time as you can. Everyone is welcome.

Volunteering in School – There are opportunities to volunteer in school for reading, trips or particular days where staff might need extra support on creative projects. School will host a volunteers morning in September or October to share more details.

Class Reps

A Class REP plays an extremely important role in communicating with the parents and the School/HISNA. Our aim is to build a sense of community in the school. We set up What's App Group for each class – this is separate to school communications and is a volunteer role. All parents receive communications – our REPs help with extra reminders, parent socials, teacher presents, communication from teachers and reminders about school events and HISNA events.

HISNA sets up a Whats App Group for all the reps and shares reminders for them to disseminate to their classes.

Our reps meet with the Heads once a term and feedback any questions or comments from their classes.
