



1. Log into your Google Account

Log in to your device and open your internet browser. Google chrome works best for this.



To sign into your Google account, click on the blue 'Sign in' button in the top right-hand corner.

There are two ways you can access Google classroom. You can either go to <https://classroom.google.com/> or click the array (the 9 dots) to open google apps.

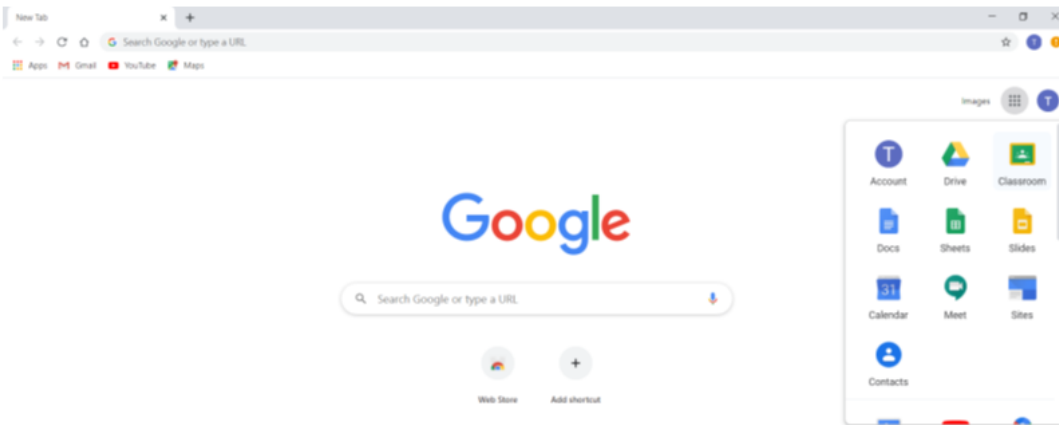


If you have another account logged in you may need to click on the icon with the initial and change between accounts.
