### English - Spellings

We have saved some resources that allow you to practise the Year 3 and 4 statutory spellings. There are crosswords, word searches and handwriting practise, along with the word list itself.

### Reading

The E-Book of 'The Story of Osiris' is saved together with questions for chapters 1 to 3. If you open the chapter document, there is a YouTube link at the top which will enable you to hear the chapter being read aloud, or you can read it yourself from the e-book. Chapter 4 relates to the separate text 'Osiris Described' and Chapter 5 is about the 'Mummy Poem'. The Year 3 reading challenges are also available for you to download and complete.

### Writing

There is an activity booklet containing a range of tasks, including grammar and punctuation challenges. We have also added the Year 3 writing challenges and we would suggest that these tasks are broken down into a structure that you are used to which is: one day planning, one or two days writing and one day editing.

### Maths

There are a variety of activity booklets that revise key skills including times tables, number bonds and the four operations – addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
