Wendy used to work at HJS and comes in regularly to dress our Christmas tree and transform our school for the summer months with her horticultural skills.



We applied for, and were awarded, a grant to support our Jubilee celebrations. The children loved our ice-creams and lollies especially the people who served it to them.




What is Parent Hub?
