Relocation of Nursery

Dear Parents and Carers

The planned Nursery building project will be going ahead this term. This was confirmed yesterday by the Local Authority. As a school we have been waiting for this news and were unsure if it would be able to happen this year or be pushed back to next year. We are delighted that it can go ahead and as a result the Nursery will be an improved building for our very youngest children and the school.

However, it means we need to relocate the current Nursery after half term to allow for the contractors to start on 13th June. In order to do this, the Nursery will be closed to children on Friday 10th June to facilitate the physical transfer of classrooms and resources and prepare the new learning environment for the children.

We will ensure the transition for children is as smooth as possible with an indoor classroom and the outside learning environment prepared to receive the children to continue their Nursery experience until the end of the summer term.

We felt it was important to welcome the children back after half term into the current Nursery and prepare them this week for the move to the temporary Nursery space. This will be located in the creativity room and the outside space directly opposite including our environmental garden.

The Nursery times will remain the same however the children will enter and exit via the main office area. The children will be greeted and dismissed by Miss Corrigan and the Nursery team as usual every day.

We have tried to minimise disruption to families by giving as much notice as possible so that childcare arrangements can be made.

We would like to take this opportunity, once again, to thank all parents, staff and children for their continued support.
