



Nursery Weekly Newsletter - 15th July

The sun has certainly been shining on our second to last week at Nursery. In PE we cooled down with some We're going on a Bear Hunt yoga which was popular with the Nursery children this week. They have been making a splash in their water play and building sandcastles after being inspired by our focus story. The children remembered that the best sandcastles are made using sand which is wet enough to hold its shape. They enjoyed decorating their sandcastles with shells, pebbles and other loose parts. We have been learning a new song at Nursery called 'elephants have wrinkles' which has had the children smiling and laughing and appears to have become a new favourite.

Week beginning 18th July

As next week is our last week of Nursery we will be spending time talking to the children about transitions and moving up to Reception after the summer holidays. To support this the children will have the opportunity to spend time exploring and playing in their new classroom and the Reception teachers will be popping in to read us a story. On Monday 18th we will have a celebratory teddy bear's picnic to end a fantastic year at Nursery. Is there something new you would like to try in the summer? What places are we going to visit? Who will we see?

Time to talk: An idea this week is for you to talk with your child about the summer holidays. Perhaps you may decide to set up a scrapbook with your child and encourage them to draw pictures and have a go at writing some letter sounds to record the experiences they have during the holiday.

Some important information and reminders:

- **Wednesday 20th July:** Please be reminded that Nursery finishes for the summer holidays on Wednesday 20th July.
- **Borrow a Book:** Please can you check at home to see if you have any outstanding books at home that belong to the Nursery and return them next week before we finish for the summer, thank you!
- **Nursery drop off and collection:** Just a reminder to say that parents/carers should follow the one way system that is marked out when dropping off and collecting the children. We ask that you continue to exit promptly to ensure a smooth and safe dismissal process. Thank you for your cooperation with this.
- **Warm weather:** We ask that every child brings a sunhat to school with them, preferably one which also covers their neck if possible. Please also apply sunscreen before the session. We spend lots of time out in the garden and want to ensure the children are protected in the sun. Please ensure their hat is clearly



labelled. Please do not send sunglasses in as these can cause injuries should your child fall whilst running or playing. We would also like to remind you that children should bring a labelled bottle of water to Nursery every day, especially during the hotter days. We appreciate your support with this.

Change of Pick Up:

- Please ensure that you email the office and also speak to a member of the Nursery team if your child is being collected by a different adult or going home with another child. This also applies if your child needs to be collected early from school.
- We also ask that you ensure the person collecting is old enough to be collecting a child from school.
- The children's safety is paramount to us so a member of staff may ask who someone is if we do not recognise them.
