English - Spellings

We have saved a number of resources which practise the year 3 and 4 statutory spellings. There are handwriting, word search and crossword activities.

Reading

The E-Book of 'Jazz Harper Space Explorer' is saved together with questions for chapters 1 to 9. If you open the chapter document, there is a YouTube link at the top which will enable your child to hear the chapter being read aloud if they wish or they can read it themselves from the e-book.

There are also a number of activities saved on Education City which focus on comprehension of different types of text.

The year 4 reading challenges are also available for you to complete.

Writing

A range of story writing prompts have been saved. We have also added the year 4 writing challenges. We would suggest that the task is broken down into a structure the children are used to which is: one day planning, one or two days writing and one day editing their writing.

Maths

There are three maths activity booklets which reinforce the skills taught this year. There are also a number of activities saved on Education City which focus on number and place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions and decimals.

Multiplication tables remain a key focus so we have saved some daily practice sheets. There are interactive resources available such as TT Rockstars and Hit the Button (<https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button>)
