Dear Year 5 Parent/Carer,

Following the safe and successful return of many of our Year 6 pupils to HJS, we are now in a position to investigate the possible return of Year 5 pupils to school. We believe that this will support their transition to year 6.

This is an INITIAL SURVEY and no decisions have been made regarding this phase yet.

To update our Covid-19 risk assessment effectively we need to have a clear indication of numbers returning. We would therefore ask ALL Year 5 parents to complete this form. Please refer back to the whole school letter sent on 19th May which outlined the school's approach to being Covid safe. It is not compulsory to send Year 5 pupils back to school.

The possible return would be from Monday 29th June and follow the same 4 day structure that year 6 are currently attending (Monday to Thursday). Pupils may not have their class teacher or be in their usual classroom. The final day of teaching would be Thursday 16th July. The school day would be slightly different to allow staggered drop off and pickups. Pupils will be in a teaching bubble of 15 children or less and will have to stay in this bubble at all times. Therefore, pupils in year 5 will not be able to access both the Y5 provision and the critical worker provision.

This form must be completed by Monday 15th (12 noon). Parents that do not want to send their child back to school, please can I ask you to still complete the form recording your reason. Parents will be unable to apply for a place following this deadline as groups will be organised to ensure pupils and staff remain safe.
