## **Year 6 Maths Mentors**

## Dear Parents/Carers

This term, there is an exciting opportunity available for Year 6 pupils to become a Maths Mentor. There are <u>four positions available</u> (per class). In order to be considered for the position of a Maths Mentor, your child will need to deliver a presentation on <u>Friday 10<sup>th</sup> November</u> to their class and teacher. Your child can deliver their presentation in the form of: a PowerPoint or speech.

## What is the role of a Maths Mentor?

The role as a Maths Mentor will be as follows:

- To work with a peer from Year 6 once a week for 15 minutes in an area of Maths that they need more support e.g- fractions, long multiplication, etc. There will be up to 4-6 sessions per half term.
- To plan lessons in advance and make your own materials.
- To deliver each of these lessons during a lunchtime.
- To write a written review how lessons went and what the next steps are
- To meet with Miss Cooper twice a term to review the impact of your teaching.
