Year 6 Bude 2020

I hope you had a good summer break and that the children have returned to school ready for the excitements and challenges of year 6. This week we were meant to be away in Bude but as you know this was postponed as a result of Covid-19. The DFE guidance around school visits has recently changed for the Autumn term however overnight visits are still not recommended currently.

Over the summer break I was in communication with Adventure International, Bude center owner, and have managed to secure another week when they will be able to accommodate all the children. As a school we felt the week should be after the SATs week and as you can imagine this is an incredibly popular time for primary schools to visit and slots are very limited.

The week we have been offered is the week of Sunday 30th May to Friday 4th June, which is half term week.
